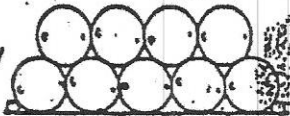

1. All drum closures must be properly in place and secure.
2. Drums which previously held a hazardous material must be labeled as if they were full of the original contents (49 CFR 173.29) and are in proper condition for transportation.
3. All drums meet the EPA definition of "EMPTY" as defined in 40 CFR 261.7.
  - (1) All wastes have been removed that can be removed using the practices commonly employed to remove materials from that container, e.g., pouring, pumping, and aspiration, and
  - (2) NO MORE THAN 2.5 CENTIMETERS (1 inch) OF RESIDUE REMAIN ON THE BOTTOM OF THE CONTAINER....
4. All drums which contained materials listed in 40 CFR 261.33(e) must be triple rinsed..

We cannot pick up any drums which do not meet these requirements. Any drums not in compliance with this notice WILL not be accepted
